

Use any size hook and corresponding yarn weight - it will just produce different sizes

### **US Crochet Terms**

## Option 1

**Black Centre** 

- 1. Make a magic ring.
- 2. Work 6 sc (single crochets) into the ring.
- 3. Pull tight and sl st (slip stitch) to join to first sc.
- 4. Fasten off black yarn.

Red Petals (Make 4 connected petals around the centre)

- 1. Join red yarn in any stitch of the black centre.
- 2. Petal 1:
  - Ch 2
  - In same st: 1 dc, 2 tr, 1 dc, ch 2, sl st

SI st to next stitch

Petals 2, 3 and 4: Repeat same sequence: Ch 2, 1 dc, 2 tr, 1 dc, ch 2, sl st

SI st to first petal to finish.

Fasten off and leave tail.





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## Option 2

#### **Black Centre**

- 1. Make a magic ring.
- 2. Work 8 sc (single crochets) into the ring.
- 3. Pull tight and sl st (slip stitch) to join to first sc.
- 4. Fasten off black yarn.

Red Petals (Make 4 connected petals around the centre)

- 1. Join red yarn in any stitch of the black centre.
- 2. Ch 3, In same st: 2 dc, 3 tr, 2 dc, ch 3, sl st
- 3. SI st to next stitch to begin next petal

Sl st to first petal to finish. Fasten off and leave tail.







# Remembrance Display Crochet Poppy Pattern

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# **Option 3 - makes the biggest poppy**

**Black Centre** 

- Make a magic ring.
- Work 12 dc (double crochets) into the ring.
- Pull tight and sl st (slip stitch) to join to first dc.
- Fasten off black yarn.

Join red yarn to any stitch of the black centre.

- In first stitch ch 3 (counts as a dc), 1 dc into same stitch
- 2 dc in each of the next 11 stitches and join with sl st in top of ch 3 (24 stitches at end of round).
- Round 3 Ch1. 2 dc in each of the next 4 stitches, sc into next stitch \*sc in next stitch, 2dc into each of next 4 stitches, sc in next stitch\*.

Repeat \* to \* 2 more times (40 stitches at end of round)

• Round 4 - \*2dc into each of the next 8 stitches, sl st between the 2 sc of previous row\*. Repeat from \* to \* three times. (68 stitches at end of round)

Fasten off and leave a tail
